

Brief note of Mini Mission-I (Oilseeds) under NMOOP Programme in Maharashtra

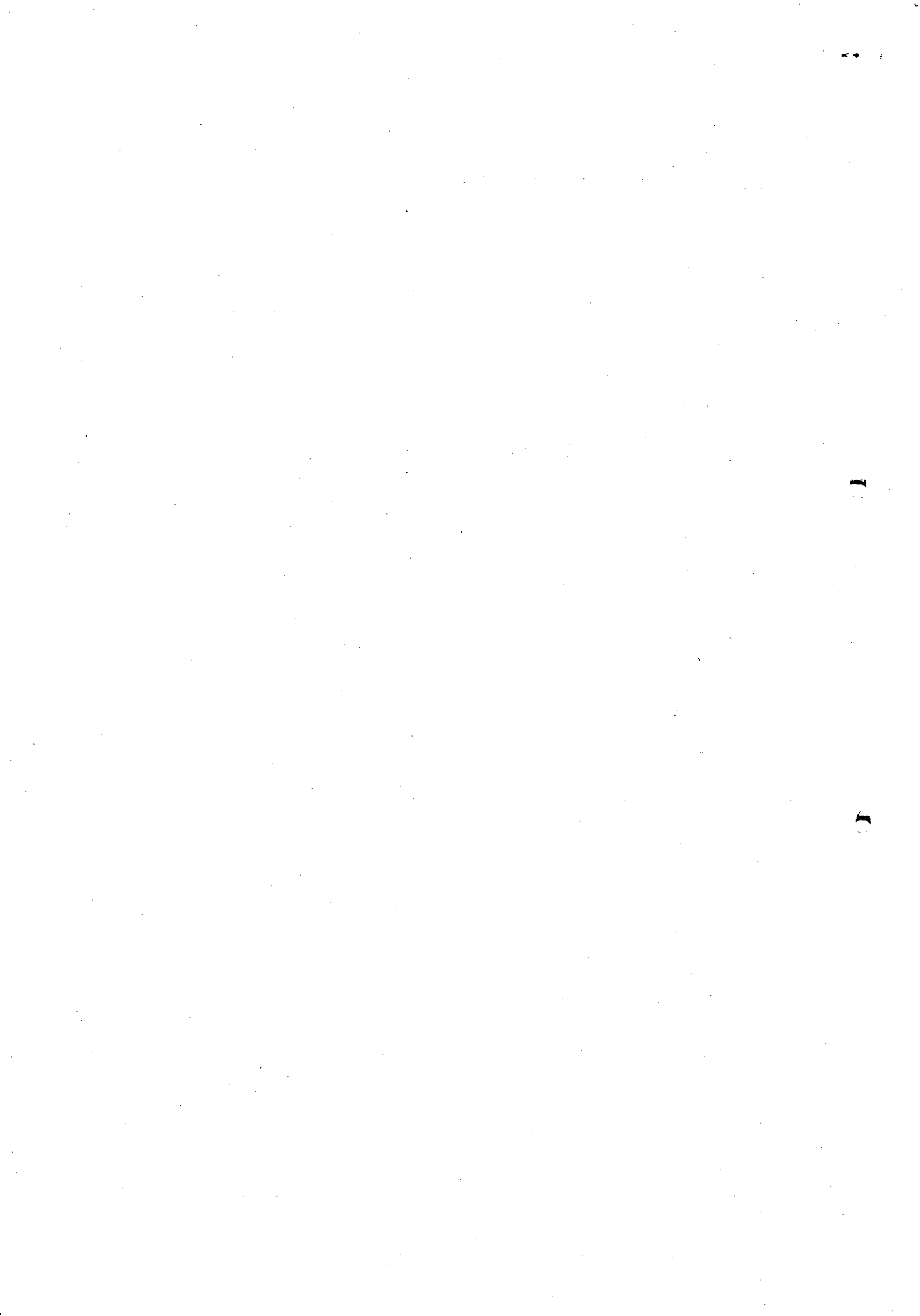
1. Status of Oilseeds Cultivation

Among 09 oilseed crops, Soybean, Groundnut, Safflower, Sunflower, Sesamum, Nigerseeds and Linseed are grown over an average area of about 38.96 lakh ha. The state was covered under erstwhile scheme of Integrated Scheme of Oilseeds, Pulses, Oil Palm and Maize (ISOPOM) implement from 2004-05 to 2013-14 and also included under National Mission on Oilseeds and Oil Palm (NMOOP) launched from 2014-15. The crop wise area, production and yield of oilseeds in the state during last couple of years is given below:

2. Mini Mission-I :-

State is included in the entire 03 Mini Missions one each for Oilseeds, Oil Palm and Tree Borne Oilseeds. However, MM-II is not under implemented in the state. Annual Action Plan (AAP) has been



approved with a Central Share of Rs. 5853.00 lakhs for 2016-17. An amount of Rs. 225.86 lakh has already been revalidated to the State and a sum of Rs. 2926.50 lakhs has been released to the State.

3. In addition to State AAP, implementation of following interventions have also been approved through Central agencies in Maharashtra:

3.1 Supply of 33154 minikits of improved varieties of oilseeds through National Seed Corporation (NSC) and Hindustan Insecticide (HIL) Ltd. during kharif 2016.

3.2 Organizing 2700 Front Line Demonstrations (FLDs): linseed (125), soybean (1650), groundnut (475), sesame (150), safflower (150) and Sunflower (150) , through the ICAR - KVKs located in the State during 2016-17.

4. **Issues for discussion:**

- State Sanction of implemented Programme is awaited from State Government;
- No any progress report received so far, State Government is requested to incur the expenditure strictly as per approved programme and monthly/ quarterly progress report may be sent regularly;
- Participation of district level Officers in monitoring of FLDs being organized by ICAR / KVKs.
- Productivity improvement of oilseeds particularly soybean, safflower and sesame.

Status of MM-III implementation in Maharashtra

Mini Mission (MM)-III (Tree Borne Oilseeds) is one of the three Mini Missions under National Mission on Oilseeds and Oil Palm (NMOOP) launched by Department of Agriculture, Cooperation & Farmers' Welfare from 2014-15 with the objectives of enhancing seed collection of TBOs and augmenting the elite planting materials for area expansion under wasteland.

The interventions under MM-III are (i) integrated development of nurseries & plantation on the wasteland, (ii) maintenance of TBOs plantation, (iii) incentives for undertaking intercropping with TBOs, (iv) research and development, (v) distribution of pre-processing, processing and oil extraction equipment, (vi) support to TRIFED, (vii) training of farmers, (viii) training of extension workers and (ix) local initiatives/contingency.

The AAP allocation (Central share) of Rs 81.01 lakhs for 2016-17 has been made for the plantation of Karanja (150 ha), Mahua (271 Ha) and Kokum (250 Ha). Besides, maintenance of plantation in about 460 Ha has also been sanctioned. Maharashtra is eligible for assistance @ 60 (Central share) : 40 (State share). A sum of Rs. 40.51 lakhs has been released during the year so far.
