Name of the Scheme: Mini Mission-I under National Mission on Oilseeds and Oil Palm (NMOOP)

**1. Status of Oilseeds Cultivation**

Among 09 oilseed crops, R & M, Soybean, Sesame, Groundnut and Castor are grown over an area of about 44.61 lakh ha. The state was covered under erstwhile scheme of Integrated Scheme of Oilseeds, Pulses, Oil Palm and Maize (ISOPOM) implement from 2004-05 to 2013-14 and also included under National Mission on Oilseeds and Oil Palm (NMOOP) launched from 2014-15. The crop wise area, production and yield of oilseeds in the state during last 3 years are given below:

2. State is included in Mini Mission-I one each for Oilseeds and Mini Mission-II for Oil Palm and Tree Borne Oilseeds. Annual Action Plan (AAP) has been approved with a Central Share of Rs. 2687.65 lakhs during 2015-16. Subsequently, AAP with a Central Share of Rs. 2070.00 lakhs has also been approved for additional area coverage for Rabi/Summer season under MM-I of NMOOP during 2015-16. An AAP of Rs.10033.26 lakhs with Central share of Rs.6019.96 lakhs has been approved under NMOOP during 2016-17. An amount of Rs.1500.00 lakhs was released to the state as

1<sup>st</sup> installment during current financial year. Expenditure of Rs. 1460.00 lakh (Central share) has been reported under MM-I of NMOOP up to the month of September, 2016 as against 1<sup>st</sup> installment. A total expenditure of Rs.3001.10 lakhs (Central share) has been reported by the state till September, 2016.

3. In addition to State AAP, implementation of following interventions has also been approved through Central agencies in Rajasthan
- 3.1 Supply of 386528 minikits of improved varieties of mustard through NSC, NAFED, KRIBHCO, HIL and IFFDC during 2015-16.
4. **Issues for discussion:**
- 4.1 Participation of district level Officers in monitoring of FLDs being organized by ICAR / KVKS.
- 4.2 Productivity improvement of oilseeds particularly of soybean, mustard and castor.
- 4.3 Productivity enhancement of groundnut through diversification of Bajra area into Groundnut
- 4.4 Promotion of soybean cultivation in relatively more productive area of Udaipur
- 4.5 Varietal Replacement

### **Status of MM-III implementation in Rajasthan**

Mini Mission (MM)-III (Tree Borne Oilseeds) is one of the three Mini Missions under National Mission on Oilseeds and Oil Palm (NMOOP) launched by Department of Agriculture, Cooperation & Farmers' Welfare from 2014-15 with the objectives of enhancing seed collection of TBOs and augmenting the elite planting materials for area expansion under wasteland.

The interventions under MM-III are (i) integrated development of nurseries & plantation on the wasteland, (ii) maintenance of TBOs plantation, (iii) incentives for undertaking intercropping with TBOs, (iv) research and development, (v) distribution of pre-processing, processing and oil extraction equipment, (vi) support to TRIFED, (vii) training of farmers, (viii) training of extension workers and (ix) local initiatives/contingency.

The AAP allocation (Central share) of Rs 124.07 lakhs for 2016-17 has been made for the plantation of Olive (300 ha), Neem (50ha), Jojoba (50 ha), Karanja (50 ha) and Mahua (50 ha). Rajasthan is eligible for assistance @ 60 (Central share) : 40 (State share). A sum of Rs. 40.00 lakhs has been released during the year so far.

Above TBOs have long gestation period of 4-5 years and during gestation period, to enhance the additional income from the plantation area, support is also provided for intercropping @ Rs. 1000/- per ha/year for critical inputs to various types of intercrops.
