Sub:- Allocation of Seed Minikits under National Mission on Oilseeds and Oil Palm (NMOOP) for Summer 2014-15.

Sir,

Annexed herewith are details of Seed Minikits allocation of Oilseeds for Summer 2014-15.

Minikits are meant for introduction and popularization of latest released / pre-released varieties/hybrids not older than 10 years among the farmers free of cost. The Central Agencies have to deliver the allotted minikits to the destination identified by the beneficiary States within the stipulated time. It is, therefore, requested that States should inform **NSC and HIL** about the quantity of seed which is to be delivered to each identified destination in the beneficiary States as per the allocation on an urgent basis under intimation to this Department.

The State Government should ensure the following:

- 1) For better monitoring and visible impact, minikits need to be allocated to all farmers in contiguous area of at least 25 ha for soybean, groundnut and mustard and at least 10 ha for other oilseed crops.
- 2) That all the Nodal Agencies deliver the Seed Minikits within the stipulated time i.e. by **10th January, 2015**.
- 3) Timely submission of Progress Report on the supply of seed minikits to this Department and Directorate of Oil Seeds Development, Hyderabad.
- 4) That the bio-fertilizer packets recommended for the crop and leaflets for package of practices are supplied with seed minikits. In case these are not supplied, the reasons should be reported to DAC.

In addition to the above, proper utilization of minikits should be ensured by the beneficiary States. Further all records including the list of the beneficiaries, results of minikits demonstrations, farmers' views etc. must be maintained correctly for verification from time to time.

The payment for the minikit supply to the Central Agencies will be released by Oil Seeds Division on receipt of their bills supported with proper acknowledgement issued by the NMOOP State Nodal Officer affixing rubber stamp having his name and designation.


