

**Brief note on NMOOP in the state of Madhya Pradesh**

**1. Status of Oilseeds Cultivation:**

MP is a major oilseeds growing state with 25% contribution in area and 23% production of oilseeds in the country. Out of 122 lakh ha area, 63.8 lakh is under soybean cultivation in MP. Mustard is also a major Rabi crop grown over an area of about 8 lakh ha. The crop wise area, production and yield of oilseed crops during last four years are given below:

- National Mission on Oilseeds and Oil Palm (NMOOP) launched in April, 2014 is under implementation in the State with two Mini Missions one (MM-I) each for Oilseeds and Tree Borne Oilseeds (TBOs).
- Regular Annual Action Plan (AAP) has been approved with a Central Share of Rs. 9658.18 lakhs during 2016-17. A amount of Rs. 2577.69lakhs was released to the State as first installment during current year. Expenditure of Rs. 1224.56 lakhs (Central share) as against the release of Rs. 2577.69lakhs (Central share) has been reported by the State Govt.

Utilization certificate up to the month of September, 2016 with an expenditure of 641.04 lakhs has been submitted by the State Govt.

4. In addition to State AAP, supply of 93500 minikits of improved varieties of Mustard through Central Seed Agencies namely NSC, NAFED, KRIBHCO and IFFDC has been approved during 2016-17.
5. **Issues for discussion, if any:**
  - 5.1 **Due to huge Unspent Balance with State Govt., it is not possible to release 2<sup>nd</sup> installment of fund under NMOOP.**
  - 5.2 **Fund utilization is very slow.**
  - 5.3 **The State Govt. has not updating the progress of the Annul Action Plan and not submitting Utilization Certificate regularly.**
  - 5.4 Possibilities for diversification of low irrigated wheat with mustard.
  - 5.5 Participation of district level Officers of State in monitoring of FLD being organized by ICAR-KVK.
  - 5.6 Domestication of protein rich soya foods in campaign mode including mid-day-meal.
  - 5.7 Sharp decline in domestic price of soybean and steps taken to help the farmers to overcome this issue

### **Status of MM-III implementation in Madhya Pradesh**

Mini Mission (MM)-III (Tree Borne Oilseeds) is one of the three Mini Missions under National Mission on Oilseeds and Oil Palm (NMOOP) launched by Department of Agriculture, Cooperation & Farmers' Welfare from 2014-15 with the objectives of enhancing seed collection of TBOs and augmenting the elite planting materials for area expansion under wasteland.

The interventions under MM-III are (i) integrated development of nurseries & plantation on the wasteland, (ii) maintenance of TBOs plantation, (iii) incentives for undertaking intercropping with TBOs, (iv) research and development, (v) distribution of pre-processing, processing and oil extraction equipment, (vi) support to TRIFED, (vii) training of farmers, (viii) training of extension workers and (ix) local initiatives/contingency.

The AAP allocation (Central share) of Rs 12.88 lakhs for 2016-17 has been made for the plantation of Karanja (21 ha), Mahua (31 Ha) and Neem (30 Ha). Besides, intercropping in 82 ha and farmer's as well as Extension Worker's trainings have also been approved under MM-III of NMOOP. M.P. is eligible for assistance @ 60 (Central share) : 40 (State share).

Some pre processing and processing equipments namely Karanja decorticator, Neem decorticator and oil expeller has also been sanctioned to exploit the existing potential. A sum of Rs. 3.44 lakhs has been released during the year so far.
