

Status of Oilseeds Development Programme in Uttar Pradesh

1. Status of Oilseeds Cultivation

The crop wise area, production and yield of oilseeds grown in the State last 02 years and 2015-16 is given below:

2. A special campaign launched by the State for promotion of sesame cultivation with a top up subsidy of Rs. 88/- on the subsidy of Ra. 12/- per kg available under NMOOP has resulted into an area increase of >1 lakh ha in Bundelkhand region. However, productivity could not be increased mainly because of heavy rains received at the time of maturity / harvest.
3. State is included in 02 Mini Missions (MM) i.e. MM-I for Oilseeds and MM-III for Tree Borne Oilseeds. A copy of progress report of 2014-15 for MM-I is attached (*Annexure-I*). Regular Annual Action Plan (AAP) for 2015-16 with a Central Share of Rs. 11.20 crores under MM-I and Rs. 0.18 crores for MM-III have been approved and a sum of Rs. 5.69 crores have been released to the State. Subsequently, AAP with a Central Share of Rs. 8.00 crores has also been approved for additional area coverage under oilseeds during Rabi/Summer 2015-16 and the total Central share of Rs. 4.00 crores has already been released to the state. Subsequently, revised approval for above mentioned AAP has also been issued based on revised pattern of sharing of 60:40 between Central and State Government.

- 4. Emphasis has been laid by the State on production and distribution of certified seeds including hybrid seeds of mustard, demonstration of improved technologies, supply of power drawn farm implements (rotavators), irrigations devices including water carrying pipes, sprinklers and diesel pump sets. Districts level Telhan Meela has also been included.
- 5. In addition to State AAP, implementation of following interventions have also been approved through Central Agencies in UP:
 - 5.1 Supply of 6750 minikits of groundnut (250) and soybean (6500) during Kharif and 2.072 lakhs minikits of mustard (2.07 lakhs) and linseed (200) during Rabi season through National Seed Corporation (NSC) and KRIBHCO during 2015-16.
 - 5.2 Organizing Cluster Front Line Demonstrations (FLDs) of mustard (1600) linseed (675) and sunflower (275) of 0.4 ha each through the ICAR-KVKs located in the State.

Status of MM-III implementation in Uttar Pradesh:

Mini Mission (MM)-III (Tree Borne Oilseeds) is one of the three Mini Missions under National Mission on Oilseeds and Oil Palm (NMOOP) launched by Department of Agriculture, Cooperation & Farmers' Welfare from 2014-15 with the objectives of enhancing seed collection of TBOs and augmenting the elite planting materials for area expansion under wasteland.

The interventions under MM-III are (i) integrated development of nurseries & plantation on the wasteland, (ii) maintenance of TBOs plantation, (iii) incentives for undertaking intercropping with TBOs, (iv) research and development, (v) distribution of pre-processing, processing and oil extraction equipment, (vi) support to TRIFED, (vii) training of farmers, (viii) training of extension workers and (ix) local initiatives/contingency.

The AAP allocation (Central share) of Rs 38.52 lakhs for 2016-17 has been made for the plantation of Neem (200ha) and Mahua (100 ha). U.P. is eligible for assistance @ 60 (Central share) : 40 (State share). A sum of Rs. 9.63 lakhs has been released during the year so far.

Above TBOs have long gestation period of 4-5 years and during gestation period, to enhance the additional income from the plantation area, support is also provided for intercropping @ Rs. 1000/- per ha/year for critical inputs to various types of intercrops.
