

A meeting was held with central seed agencies at 11:00 AM on 3<sup>rd</sup> October, 2016 under the chairmanship of Joint Secretary (Oilseeds) in his chamber at Krishi Bhawan to review the progress of seed production, minikits distribution and status of fund release. The seed agencies submitted the status of target and achievements on purchase of breeder seed, production of foundation and certified seed, distribution of minikits and payment of bills as per details given below:

- All agencies should ensure and confirm their Certified seed production programme of Minor oilseeds crop like Lin seed, Safflower, Niger and Sesamum.

The following decisions were taken in the meeting:

- All the agencies should submit details of season-wise, crop-wise, variety-wise and category-wise locations of seed production, seed distribution and minikits supply of programme which should be validated by the CDDs and Consultants during their field visit to states.
- Quarterly report of progress should be submitted by central agencies to the department regularly.
- Payment of bills will be settled strictly in accordance with the targets fixed in the Annual Action Plan submitted by central seed agencies and allocation made by the Oilseeds Division.
- A letter may be put up for relaxation of sales tax/ service tax charged on certified seeds/ minikits during their movement from state to state as no tax is levied on certified seed movement.
- The Division should prepare details of seed category-wise release of funds and payment made to central agencies **enclosed Annexure**.
- NSC has assured to submit bills amounting to Rs. 20.00 crore within a fortnight. Similarly other agencies have also assured to submit the bills at the earliest.

Joint Secretary (Oilseeds) desired that the central seed agencies should make all out efforts for quality seed production of newly release varieties of all oilseeds including minor oilseeds. He assured that any constraint faced by the agencies should be brought to the notice of DAC&FW for facilitation.
